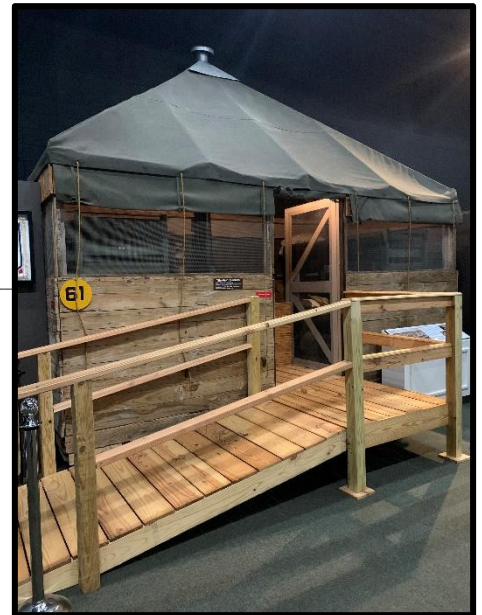
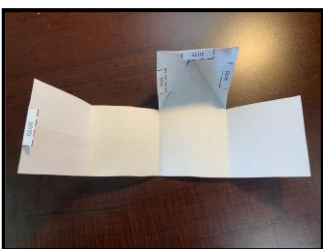
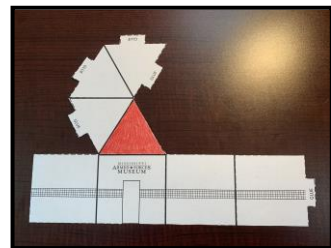
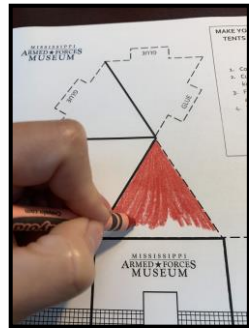
MATERIALS

Coloring supplies

Scissors

PDF print out

Tape / glue (tape is better)

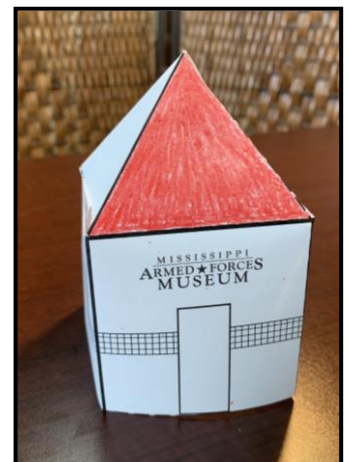


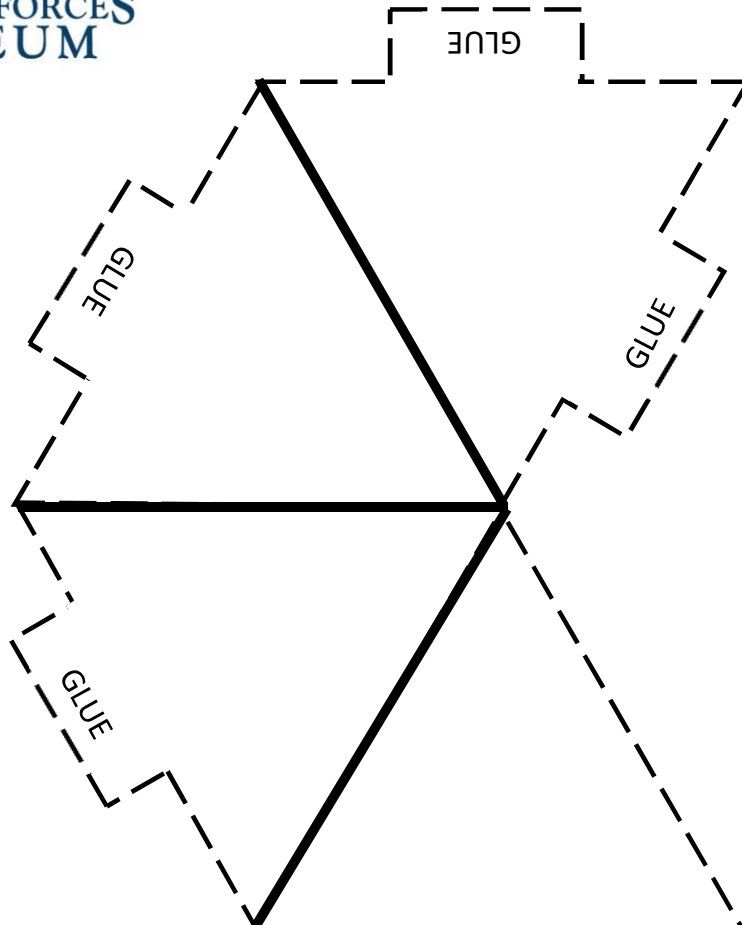
DIRECTIONS

1. Gather your coloring supplies and apply your creativity to the Six Man Tent!
2. Cut along the dotted lines, careful not to cut the solid lines of the tent.
3. Fold all of the sold lines inward.
4. Tape or glue the tab on the roof to create a four-sided pyramid.
5. Tape or glue the tab on the wall of the tent to create a cube.
6. Now, it is time to attach the roof to the walls. Tape or glue the remaining three tabs on the roof to the walls by reaching inside the box and taping them down.

**MAKE YOUR OWN POP-UP TENT LIKE THE SIX MAN
TENTS AT CAMP SHELBY DURING THE FIRST
WORLD WAR**



1. Color your tent's roof and four sidewalls.
2. Cut along the dashed lines of the paper tent, careful to keep it all in one piece.
3. Fold along each solid line. The bottom will create a cube and the top will form a four-sided pyramid.
4. Tape or glue roof and sidewalls. (Tape works best!)
